I am writing to you once more on behalf of my constituent Judith Majlath of 10 Kempsford Gardens, London, SW5 9LH.

Mrs Majlath has been in regular contact with my office following the disappearance of her sister Eva Rhodes, and the confirmation of her death in Hungary.

Concern has been raised that the Hungarian authorities have not provided an adequate level of information and support following confirmation of Mrs Rhodes death. I understand that Mrs Rhodes' next of kin have still not received any of the post that was sent to her in the months since her disappearance, and that there remains uncertainty about the return of Ms Rhodes' remains.

I would be grateful for your assurances that every effort is being made to keep Mrs Rhodes family informed of developments in Hungary, and that all appropriate steps are being taken to ensure that the Hungarian authorities provide all due assistance to Eva Rhodes' next of kin at this very difficult time.
